Registering your birds on the Scottish Kept Bird Register

From 1 September 2024, all bird keepers - even those who keep a single bird - must register their bird locations on the new **Scottish Kept Bird Register** (SKBR). Registration will be **free**, quick and simple.

Keepers must register, or re-register (if they were previously registered on the GBPR), their bird locations online or by telephone between 1 September and 1 December 2024. This is a legal requirement.

By registering your birds' location, you will receive vital biosecurity information to help protect your flock from disease, along with disease control information in case you are affected by a disease control zone. You will also help government contain and eradicate notifiable avian diseases, such as highly pathogenic avian influenza and Newcastle disease.
